2. Achieve a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75
3. Pass the IL Test of Academic Proficiency (TAP) **OR** receive a score of at least 22 on the ACT Plus Writing or a composite score of 1110 on the SAT evidence-based reading, writing, mathematics
4. Be free of a felony sex or drug conviction
5. Complete the FBI and State of IL Fingerprint & Background Check process
