NOTES:

Students must submit a completed Teacher Education Program application before taking courses beyond ECED 300 or equivalent course. The following criteria must be met for acceptance into the Teacher Education Program:

1. Pass ECED 300 with a grade of C or better
2. Achieve a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75
3. Pass the Illinois Test of Academic Achievement (TAP) OR receive a score of at least 22 on the ACT Plus Writing or a composite score of 1030 on the SAT critical reading and mathematics
4. Be free of a felony sex or drug conviction
