



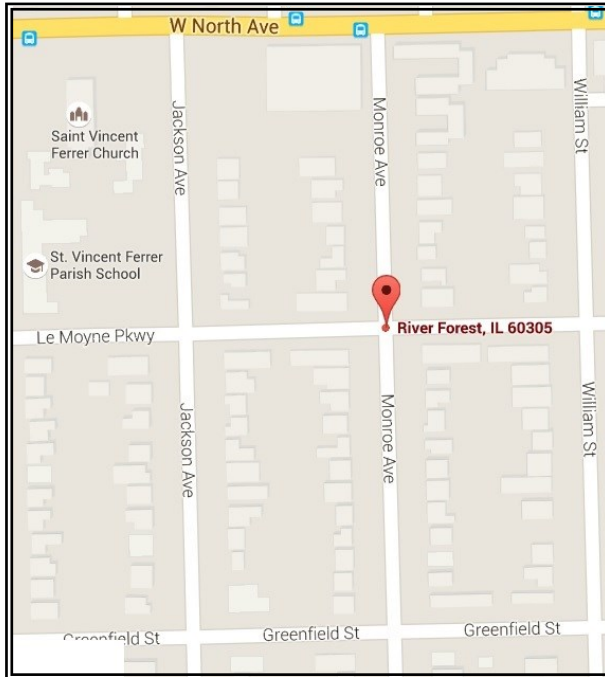

Incident Summary

A Willard School student reported on November 11th at approximately 3:30pm, the student was walking near the intersection of LeMoyne and Monroe, where the student saw an unknown subject standing in a driveway near a vehicle. The subject asked the student to “come here”. The subject did not approach the student, and the student ignored the subject and continued walking. The subject was described as a white male, shorter, 45-50 years old, with short black hair, a darker or tanned complexion, wearing a blue shirt, black pants, and brown dress shoes. The vehicle was described as a plain, white, work van with windows at the rear. An investigation has determined that the subject does not live at the address where he was seen by the student, and neither he nor the vehicle are involved with repairs being done at the residence. This bulletin is being sent for awareness due to the suspicious nature of the subject. RFPD reminds our community members to always be aware of their surroundings and do not hesitate to call 911 to report suspicious circumstances.
